

Construction Alert:



SOUTHWEST GAS

35th Avenue and Rose Garden Lane

Beginning soon

A contractor for Southwest Gas will be replacing the existing natural gas pipeline in the area from 35th Avenue west to 39th Avenue, and from Mohawk Lane north to Melinda Lane. This work is estimated to be complete in November 2016, and will include only minimal work in Rose Garden Lane. Existing Southwest Gas customers should not experience an interruption in gas service, unless notified.

You can expect:

- Utility locators to mark existing utilities before construction begins.
- Crews to video existing streets and service location areas to document pre-construction conditions, and also video inspect residential sewer lines to ensure they are conflict free.
- Boring under, or trenching, the existing roadway and potholes to be excavated along the installation route. Crews will coordinate work in front of driveways/side streets to provide access.
- If you are a Southwest Gas customer, crews will need access to the existing gas meter locations on your property. **If your access is restricted, locked, or you have animals, please contact us to coordinate.**
- Abandonment of the existing pipeline will follow pipeline installation and service connections.
- Roads to remain open for travel; however, if needed a flagger operation may be used to assist in directing traffic through the work area. Please be patient and observe all traffic control signage and personnel.
