- 1. NATURAL GAS EMERGENCY: If you suspect a natural gas leak, call 911 and Southwest Gas at 877-860-6020.
- **2. DIG ALERT** ("Call Before You Dig"): Call 8-1-1 at least two business days prior to digging to have underground utilities marked for free. Failure to call prior to digging is the leading cause of damage to underground pipelines.
- **3. CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE**: To start, stop, move, temporarily/ permanently abandon, or reinstate gas service, the owner or legal designee of the property should call Southwest Gas at 1-877-860-6020 or visit www.swgas.com.
- **4.** EASEMENT OR RIGHT-OF-WAY ABANDONMENT REQUEST: Send an email to SCDEngineering@swgas.com
- **5. SAFETY STANDBY/BORE MONITOR**: When working in vicinity of a high pressure gas facility or boring, call Southwest Gas Construction at **760-951-4027** Mon-Fri, 07:00 AM 4:00 PM. For afterhours requests, please contact Dispatch at **877-860-6020.** Standby requests must be made 24 hours prior to commencing work.
