Southwest Gas Corporation Files Application with Public Utilities Commission of Nevada Seeking Approval to Expand Natural Gas Infrastructure (Notice to Spring Creek Expansion Area Customers)

Southwest Gas Corporation filed an Application with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada June 13, 2019 seeking approval to expand natural gas infrastructure to serve Spring Creek, Nevada and the surrounding area pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes 704.9925 and the Regulations approved in Docket No. 15-05025. The estimated increase in the Company's Year 1 revenues from prospective customers in Spring Creek, Nevada associated with the gas Infrastructure Expansion Rate (IER) and the Local Expansion Area Charge (LEAC) is \$54,200.

The table below shows the estimated average monthly bill for each rate schedule. Individual customer bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.
