Boiler Equipment Rebates

Did you know that boilers generally account for more than 40% of the heating energy in commercial buildings? Southwest Gas commercial customers in California can take advantage of rebates to improve the efficiency of an existing boiler, or on the purchase and installation of a new, high-efficiency boiler.



*All new boilers must be installed with a modulating burner control with a minimum 5:1 turndown ratio. New boilers \geq 10 MMBtuh must also be installed with an O₂ trim control pad.
