- Seal leaks around doors, windows, and other openings with caulking or weather-stripping.
- Before the heating season, have furnace checked by a licensed HVAC contractor.

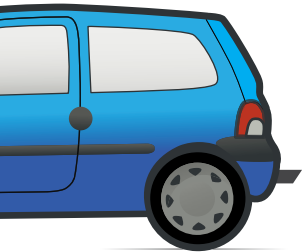

If the average American household viewed and paid bills online, it would avoid producing 171 pounds of greenhouse gas emissions, preserving 24 square feet of forestland each year.

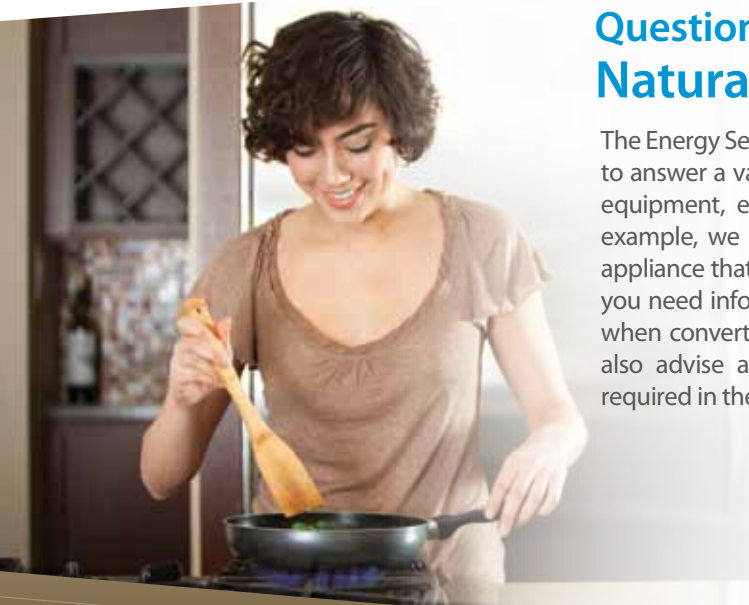
