SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION

General Revenues Adjustment Hearing and Consumer Session Docket No. 10-12003 – Public Notice

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) has requested authorization from the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) to adjust customers' rates in Southern and Northern Nevada, pursuant to the General Revenues Adjustment (GRA) provision of its Tariff. The GRA only affects residential and general service customers. If the PUCN approves Southwest's request, natural gas revenues will increase by approximately \$351,000 or 0.09 percent in Southern Nevada, and decrease by approximately \$1.9 million or 1.49 percent in Northern Nevada. The PUCN may set rates which may be higher or lower than the rates proposed in the application.
