Effective July 1, 2011, natural gas rates for Southwest's residential and general service customers were increased by approximately \$304,615, or 0.08 percent, as a result of the General Revenues Adjustment (GRA) provision of Southwest's Gas Tariff. This change is in addition to the Base Tariff Energy Rate change that will also go into effect on July 1.

The GRA ensures the Company only receives from its customers the revenue authorized by the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. If the Company over-collects or under-collects authorized revenue, it returns or recovers the over- or under-collected revenue through a GRA rate adjustment. This GRA rate adjustment will increase Residential Single Family rates 0.3 percent, decrease Residential Multi-Family rates 1.1 percent, increase Small General Service rates 1.0 percent, decrease Medium General Service rates 0.8 percent, and increase Large General Service rates 0.1 percent.

Customers whose bills contain billing days prior to the July 1 rate change will be billed at the old rate for their use before the rate change and at the new rate for use after the rate change. Revised rates which include the GRA rate adjustment are listed for each rate schedule.
