- Set your water heater thermostat at 120°F for comfortable hot water for most uses.
- Repair leaky faucets and showerheads promptly to reduce water waste.
- Run your dishwasher and washing machine only when full.
- Insulate exposed hot water pipes.
- If you replace your heating and cooling equipment this summer, make sure you choose natural gas for your heating system. When cooler weather comes around, you'll be glad you did!
