Effective July 1, 2013, residential and general service rates were changed as a result of the General Revenues Adjustment (GRA) provision. In Southern Nevada, this results in an increase in revenues of approximately \$2.88 million or 0.96 percent. This change is in addition to the Base Tariff Energy Rate change that will also go into effect on July 1, 2013.

The GRA ensures that Southwest Gas only receives from its customers the revenues authorized by the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. If Southwest Gas over-collects or under-collects authorized revenue, it returns or recovers the over- or under-collected amount through the GRA rate adjustment.



The table shows the new revised rates effective on July 1, 2013 and the percent change from the current rates for each rate schedule. Customers whose bills contain billing days prior to the July 1 rate change will be billed at the old rate for their use before the rate change and at the new rate for use after the rate change.
