

PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) herewith submits Advice Letter No. 836 applicable to its Northern California Division. This advice filing is submitted pursuant to Preliminary Statement 18I pertaining to Southwest's Gas Cost Incentive Mechanism (GCIM) approved in Application 04-11-009. There are no tariff sheets associated with this filing.

Purpose

The purpose of this filing is to request authorization to make accounting entries to reflect shared savings associated with Southwest's GCIM for the reporting period November 1, 2008 through October 31, 2009. Southwest requests authorization to make accounting entries to reflect the shared savings of \$84,843 in Southwest's Northern California rate jurisdiction. Of this amount, seventy-five percent, or \$63,632.25, is to be shared with customers, while the remaining twenty-five percent, or \$21,210.75, is to be retained by shareholders. There are no shared savings or costs associated with Southwest's Southern California rate jurisdiction for this reporting period. Southwest's annual GCIM report, which provides the supporting documentation for the calculated shared savings, has been provided to the Energy Division and the Division of Ratepayer Advocates under separate cover.

Effective Date

Southwest believes this Advice Letter is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 2 pursuant to General Order 96-B. Southwest respectfully requests this Advice Letter be approved effective February 27, 2010, which is thirty (30) calendar days after the date filed.

Protest

Anyone wishing to protest this filing may do so by sending a letter within 20 days of the filing. The protest should set forth the grounds upon which it is based and should be submitted expeditiously. There is no restriction on who may file a protest. Protests should be mailed or faxed to:


