The PGA Balancing Account Adjustment is applicable to customers converting from sales service to transportation service for the greater period of either 12 months or the conclusion of the amortization period upon which the Balancing Account Adjustment was developed. The volume charge for customer-secured natural gas transportation will also be subject to the TFF Surcharge, if applicable. The TFF Surcharge shall be the product of the customer-secured volumes transported, multiplied by the monthly projected cost of gas, excluding franchise fees and uncollectibles, multiplied by the most current authorized franchise fee factor.
