The purpose of this filing is to adjust Southwest's Southern and Northern Nevada Base Tariff Energy Rates. Rates for Southwest's Southern Nevada customers will increase \$0.01027 per therm and rates for Southwest's Northern Nevada customers will decrease \$0.01571 per therm. These rates will become effective November 1, 2007.

Customers are being notified of the rate change by means of a bill insert included with each bill beginning approximately October 5, 2007, as required by NRS 704.110(8)(b)(1). Copies of the bill inserts are attached. No other notice is required per NRS 703.320.

On September 28, 2007, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed its quarterly Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. Effective November 1, 2007, natural gas rates for Southwest's Southern Nevada customers will increase by \$0.01027 per therm, which represents an approximate 1.2 percent increase in the gas cost portion of rates. A single-family residential customer's average monthly bill will increase \$0.43. The total increase is approximately \$3.9 million for all customer classes.

The chart on the back reflects the increase for the average monthly bill for each customer class. Actual changes to individual customers' bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.

Monthly bills that reflect usage both before and after the effective date will be prorated to reflect the days billed at the old and new rates.

On September 28, 2007, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed its quarterly Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. Effective November 1, 2007, natural gas rates for Southwest's Northern Nevada customers will decrease by \$0.01571 per therm, which represents an approximate 1.5 percent decrease in the gas cost portion of rates. A single-family residential customer's average monthly bill will decrease \$0.99. The total decrease is approximately \$1.5 million for all customer classes.

The chart on the back reflects the decrease for the average monthly bill for each customer class. Actual changes to individual customers' bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.

Monthly bills that reflect usage both before and after the effective date will be prorated to reflect the days billed at the old and new rates.
