

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) tenders herewith for filing the following tariff sheets applicable to its Nevada Gas Tariff No. 7:

The purpose of this filing is to establish the Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) and the Deferred Energy Account Adjustment (DEAA) rate, collectively referred to as the Gas Cost Rate, for Southern and Northern Nevada, effective October 1, 2011.

In Southern Nevada, the BTER rate will increase by \$0.00758 per therm. Pursuant to the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (Commission) Order in Docket No. 11-07001, there is no change to the DEAA rate this quarter. As such, the overall change in the Southern Nevada Gas Cost Rate will be an increase of \$0.00758 per therm.

In Northern Nevada, the BTER will increase by \$0.00737 per therm, and as ordered by the Commission in the above-referenced docket, the DEAA rate will decrease by \$0.025 per therm, the maximum allowed by NRS 704.110(8). As such, the overall change in the Northern Nevada Gas Cost Rate will be a decrease of \$0.01763 per therm.

Customers are being notified of the rate change by means of a bill insert included with each bill beginning approximately September 7, 2011, as required by NRS 704.110(8)(b)(1). Copies of the bill inserts are attached. No other notice is required per NRS 703.320.



### **Quarterly Gas Cost Rate Adjustment—Southern Nevada Division**

On September 1, 2011, Southwest Gas Corporation filed a Quarterly Gas Cost Rate Adjustment with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. On October 1, 2011, rates for Southern Nevada customers will increase by \$0.00758 per therm. The result of this filing is an increase in annual revenues of \$2,919,484 or 0.8%.

The transactions and recorded cost of natural gas which are the basis for the quarterly rate adjustment will be reviewed for reasonableness and prudence in the next annual rate adjustment proceeding.

Monthly bills that reflect usage both prior to and after the effective date of the rate adjustment will be billed the old rates for the usage prior to the effective date and the new rates for the usage after the effective date.

The table on the back of this notice shows the change in an average monthly bill for each rate schedule. The change to individual customer bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.

### **Quarterly Gas Cost Rate Adjustment—Northern Nevada Division**

On September 1, 2011, Southwest Gas Corporation filed a Quarterly Gas Cost Rate Adjustment with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. On October 1, 2011, rates for Northern Nevada customers will decrease by \$0.01763 per therm. The result of this filing is a decrease in annual revenues of \$1,667,227 or 1.65%.

The transactions and recorded cost of natural gas which are the basis for the quarterly rate adjustment will be reviewed for reasonableness and prudence in the next annual rate adjustment proceeding.

Monthly bills that reflect usage both prior to and after the effective date of the rate adjustment will be billed the old rates for the usage prior to the effective date and the new rates for the usage after the effective date.

The table on the back of this notice shows the change in an average monthly bill for each rate schedule. The change to individual customer bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.
