## Annual Deferred Energy Account Adjustment Hearing and Consumer Session Docket No. 08-05008 — Public Notice

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) has requested authorization from the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) to adjust customers' gas cost rates. In its Northern Nevada Division, Southwest is requesting authorization to reduce the Deferred Energy Account Adjustment (DEAA) to a credit of \$0.08956. If approved, Southwest's request would result in a decrease in revenues of \$4,608,505. Southwest is also requesting authority to adjust other gas-related charges applicable to transportation customer service. Evidentiary hearings will be held beginning Tuesday, September 30, 2008 at 10 a.m. at the PUCN Offices, 101 Convention Center Drive, Hearing Room A, Las Vegas, NV.
