IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT NATURAL GAS RATES FOR SOUTH LAKE TAHOE, CALIFORNIA CUSTOMERS

NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARINGS IN APPLICATION (A.) 07-12-022

On December 21, 2007, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed an application (A.07-12-022) with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) requesting authority to change its rates and charges for natural gas service effective January 1, 2009. For the South Lake Tahoe rate jurisdiction, Southwest is requesting an increase of \$2.1 million. If the Commission grants Southwest's request, residential customers in the South Lake Tahoe area will see an annual average increase in their bills of 12.5 percent beginning on January 1, 2009. The proposed increases for all customer classes are shown below. Southwest has filed its request for rate relief to recover the reasonable costs of owning and operating the facilities used to distribute natural gas to its customers and for Southwest to satisfactorily fulfill its customer service obligations. Southwest is also requesting post-test year changes to rates and charges to become effective on January 1 of each year for 2010 through 2013.
