Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) has requested authorization from the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada (PUCN) to adjust customers' rates. The rate adjustments Southwest is requesting in its Southern Nevada Division include: (1) a decrease to the Deferred Energy Account Adjustment (DEAA) of \$ 0.10282 per therm and (2) a decrease to the Delivery Charge of \$0.00514 per therm. Southwest's request would result in decreases in revenues of \$39,799,890 and \$2,441,768 associated with the DEAA and delivery charge adjustment, respectively.
