



Base Tariff Energy Rate Change — Southern Nevada Division

On September 1, 2010, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed its quarterly Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) change with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. The annualized change in revenues is a decrease of \$2,492,961 or 0.59%. Effective October 1, 2010, natural gas rates for Southwest’s Southern Nevada customers will decrease by \$0.00638 per therm.

The table on the back of this notice shows the changes for the average monthly bill for each customer class. The change to individual customer bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.

Monthly bills that reflect usage both before and after the effective date will be prorated to reflect the days billed at the old and new rates.
