Subject: To remove the CARE Re-Enrollment Form 902.70 from Southwest Gas' California Gas Tariff.

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest Gas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its California Gas Tariff. The tariff sheets being modified as a result of this submission are presented on Attachment A.

Purpose

The purpose of this submission is to eliminate the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) Re-Enrollment Form 902.70 (CARE Form 902.70) from Southwest Gas' California Gas Tariff.

Background

Southwest Gas mailed CARE Form 902.70 monthly to previously enrolled CARE customers who failed to recertify their income status and were removed from the CARE program. Southwest Gas no longer plans to use the CARE Form 902.70 given the costly postage surrounding its use. Instead, customers who do not recertify and are removed from the CARE program will be included in other outreach efforts targeted to all non-CARE customers.

Therefore, Southwest Gas seeks to remove CARE Form 902.70 from its Gas tariff.

Effective Date

Southwest Gas believes this Advice Letter is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 2 (Effective after Energy Division Approval) pursuant to General Order (GO) 96-B. Southwest Gas respectfully requests that the tariff sheets filed herein be made effective October 30, 2019, which is 30 days from the date submitted.


