<u>Subject</u>: Establishment of the General Rate Case Memorandum Account 2021 Pursuant to the November 10, 2020 Administrative Law Judge Ruling

Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest Gas) hereby submits for approval by the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its California Gas Tariff. The tariff sheets being modified as a result of this submission are listed on Attachment A.

<u>Purpose</u>

The purpose of this submission is to establish the General Rate Case Memorandum Account 2021 (GRCMA2021) pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge Ruling of Patricia B. Miles issued on November 10, 2020 (ALJ Ruling).

Background

On August 30, 2019, Southwest Gas filed Application (A.) 19-08-015 requesting authority to increase rates and charges for natural gas service in California, effective January 1, 2021.

On November 6, 2019, Southwest Gas filed a motion¹ requesting authority to establish a general rate case memorandum account to track the changes in revenue requirement beginning January 1, 2021 through the effective date of the final decision in A.19-08-015. Southwest Gas requested the memorandum account to ensure recovery of revenue shortfalls or the return of overcollections should there be any delay in the Commission's authorization of Southwest Gas' revenue requirement requests and the implementation of rates past January 1, 2021. Southwest Gas' Motion was uncontested. On November 10, 2020, the ALJ Ruling granted Southwest Gas' request.

Therefore, in accordance with the ALJ Ruling, Southwest Gas submits this Advice Letter to establish the GRCMA2021.

This Advice Letter will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

PURPOSE The purpose of the GRCMA2021 is to record and track the Company's margin revenue shortfalls caused by a delay of requested rate relief in its Test year 2021 general rate case Application 19-08-015 (A.19-08-015). The GRCMA2021 is an interest-bearing memorandum account. The GRCMA2021 is authorized pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge Ruling dated November 10, 2020. The GRCMA2021 is effective January 1, 2021. 35B. APPLICABILITY The GRCMA2021 balance will be recovered from all customer classes, unless specifically requested for exclusion by the Company. 35C. ACCOUNTING Entries to the GRCMA2021 will be made on a monthly basis for the period January 1, 2021 until such time as the decision and rate relief granted in A.19-08-015 become effective. 1. A debit or credit entry equal to the difference between the Company's currently authorized margin rates and the Company's margin rates proposed in A.19-08-015 calculated by multiplying, for each customer class, the difference between authorized and proposed margin rates by the throughput related to that customer class. 2. An entry to record interest on the GRCMA2021 balance calculated in entry (1) above, calculated by averaging the beginning and ending balance in the memorandum account at the rate of 1/12 of the most recent month's interest rate on Commercial Paper (prime, 3-month), published in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15. Should publication of the interest rate on Commercial Paper (prime, 3-month) be discontinued, interest will accrue at the rate of 1/12 of the most recent month's interest rate on Commercial Paper, which most closely approximates the discounted rate, and which is published in the Federal Reserve Statistical Release, H.15, or its successor publication. 3. At such time as Commission authorized margin rates in A.19-08-015 are determined, an adjusting entry calculated based on the gas throughput last adopted, will be made to reflect the difference between the Company's Ν proposed margin rates and Commission authorized margin rates.
