The purpose of this transmittal is to amend Schedule No. SLT-12-CARE Residential Gas Service on Sheet No. 71, South Lake Tahoe Statement of Rates. The Southwest Margin rates for both Baseline Quantities and Tier II rate components are incorrect. The correct rates should be \$.00814 and \$.08891, respectively. These typographical errors do not impact the overall Effective Sale Rate, which remain unchanged as result of these revisions.
