

Purpose

Southwest Gas is making this filing to correct a typographical error on Sheet No. 164 of its California Gas Tariff. The elevation range for Altitude Group 53 is 2,300 – 3,499 feet, not 2,300 – 3,400 as currently indicated on Sheet No. 164.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedule or rule.

Effective Date

Southwest Gas believes this Advice Letter is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 1 (effective pending disposition) pursuant to General Order 96-B. Southwest Gas respectfully requests the changes proposed herein are approved with an effective date November 16, 2012, which is the date filed.



C. DETERMINATION OF THERMS TO BE BILLED (Continued)

3. Accounts Supplied at Standard Delivery Pressure

The billing factor appropriate for accounts metered at standard delivery pressure will be developed from the average gas heating value, expressed in Btu per cubic foot, divided either by 1,000 for meter registrations in units of 100 cubic feet (Ccf) or by 100 for registrations in units of 1,000 cubic feet (Mcf), and the result will be multiplied by the proper combined altitude and delivery pressure adjustment value from the following tabulation:
