### Base Tariff Energy Rate Change — Southern Nevada Division

On June 30, 2008, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed its quarterly Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. Effective August 1, 2008, natural gas rates for Southwest's Southern Nevada customers will increase by \$0.00358 per therm, which represents an approximate 0.5 percent increase in the gas cost portion of rates. A single-family residential customer's average monthly bill will increase \$0.15. The total increase is approximately \$1.4 million for all customer classes.

The table on the back of this notice shows the increase for the average monthly bill for each customer class. Actual changes to individual customers' bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.

Monthly bills that reflect usage both before and after the effective date will be prorated to reflect the days billed at the old and new rates.



### Base Tariff Energy Rate Change — Northern Nevada Division

On June 30, 2008, Southwest Gas Corporation (Southwest) filed its quarterly Base Tariff Energy Rate (BTER) with the Public Utilities Commission of Nevada. Effective August 1, 2008, natural gas rates for Southwest's Northern Nevada customers will increase by \$0.01845 per therm, which represents an approximate 2.1 percent increase in the gas cost portion of rates. A single-family residential customer's average monthly bill will increase \$1.19. The total increase is approximately \$1.8 million for all customer classes.

The table on the back of this notice shows the increase for the average monthly bill for each customer class. Actual changes to individual customers' bills will vary depending on the amount of gas consumed.


